Rules with AI Loveless

Think you know the rules? Check this out...

What's the official ruling?

A recent tee shot I hit split the ball in two! One half went 30 yards to the left, the other 30 yards to the right. It was a new ball that I'd only used for a few holes.

According to Rule 5-3, if a ball breaks into pieces as a result of the stroke, the stroke is cancelled and the golfer plays again, without penalty, from the original spot. A ball that's unfit for play (visibly cut, cracked or "out-of-round") may be substituted mid-hole. But beware: A ball that's merely dinged up (scratched, scraped, mud-caked, etc.) remains fit for play and is not substitutable mid-hole. If you mistakenly replace a fit-for-play ball before completing a hole, the penalty is loss of hole in match play and two strokes in stroke play. Pays to know the rules, it could happen to you!!!! Stroke saver....

Desert Mashie Cup 2021

Desert Mashie Members,

This is Desert Mashie's 75th year in existence. After soliciting ideas from several members across the valley, we have decided to try something **NEW**. We are attempting to take our club to another level. In the past we accommodated "ALL" members throughout the valley. In recent years, we have not been as effective in meeting the desires of several our members who want to play a greater variety of courses. We are going to try and expand where we play and provide a competitive environment that mirrors our past. We are also seeking to recruit both new and former members as we celebrate 75 years in 2021. We have 143 golfing members to date.

With Covid-19 affecting most golf courses, organizations, and operating procedures, we have developed ideas to keep our events simple and as contact free as possible.

"DESERT MASHIE CUP"

- YOU MUST BE A 2021 DESERT MASHIE MEMBER PRIOR TO 4/1/2021 TO ACCRUE POINTS TOWARDS THE DESERT MASHIE CUP.
- THE CUP WILL CONSIST OF 13 OPPORTUNITIES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR FOR INDIVIDUAL GOLFERS TO ACCRUE POINTS FROM THEIR NET SCORE PLACEMENT BASED ON A PRE-DETERMINED POINT SYSTEM. COPIES OF POINT SYSTEM BY REQUEST.
- THE CUP WILL CONSIST OF ONE (1) FLIGHT FOR EACH EVENT. (EXCEPT 72ND ANNUAL WHICH WILL BE FLIGHTED, AND POINTS WILL BE AWARDED EACH DAY)
- POINTS WILL ALSO BE AWARDED EACH DAY AT THE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP AND WILL NOT BE FLIGHTED. THE CLUB CHAMPI-ON (LOW GROSS) AND PRESIDENT'S CUP (LOW NET) WINNERS WILL STILL RECEIVE FREE ENTRY INTO THE FOLLOWING YEAR'S ANNUAL.
- IN CASE OF A TIE FOR FIRST PLACE POINTS IN A MONTHLY EVENT. "THE TIE WILL BE BROKEN IN WAY OF A SCORECARD

PLAYOFF". ALL OTHER TIES WILL ACCRUE POINTS FOR THEIR PLACEMENT AND SPLIT THOSE POINTS.

EXAMPLE: PLAYER A, PLAYER B AND PLAYER C ALL THREE PLAYERS FINISH TIED FOR SECOND, THEY WILL ALL ACCRUE POINTS FOR SECOND, THIRD AND FOURTH PLACE. (300 = 2ND + 190 = 3RD + 135 = 4TH FOR A TOTAL OF 625 POINTS. 625 IS THEN DIVIDED BY 3 = 208.33). ALL THREE (3) PLAYERS WOULD ACCRUE THE AVERAGED 208.33 POINTS.

Payouts for the TOP 24 POINTS LEADERS will be paid at the New Year's Eve golf event 2021. (payout is based on overall participation of 500 players throughout the 13 events). Subject to change.

Each event will only cost \$20 over the green fee excluding the Desert Mashie 72nd Annual 5/1 - 5/2 2021 held at McCormick Ranch and the Club Championship at Lookout Mountain 9/4 - 9/5 2021.

Monthly optional games: 50/50 (\$5), Flighted Skins (\$10) and Daily Top 4 Net Payouts (\$5).

We will attempt to contract play across the valley to include the East, West, North, and South areas with reasonable pricing as a priority. The 2021 Desert Mashie Cup and Golf Schedule is designed in hopes of recruiting new and former members, keeping current members, and enhancing the Desert Mashie Golf Organization with something NEW. We clearly understand not every member will be able to attend every event. However, we do not believe that will significantly affect their ability to place in the final Cup standings. We are looking forward to making the 75th year of the Desert Mashie Golf Organization fun, safe, exciting and rewarding for all.
