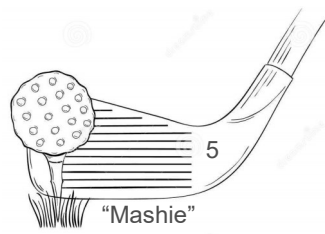

Rules with AI Loveless

We here in Arizona are often in over seed modes...please adhere to a recent rule change since Jan 2019:

The Topic: Repairing damage (spike marks!) on the putting green

The Old Rule: A player may only repair ball-marks or old hole plugs on the putting green.

The New Rule: Golfers are now allowed to repair almost any damage on the green, such as spike marks, ball-marks, indentations from a club or flagstick, and animal damage. They are not permitted to repair **aeration holes**, natural surface imperfections, or natural wear of the hole.

Point: You cannot repair aeration holes on the green!

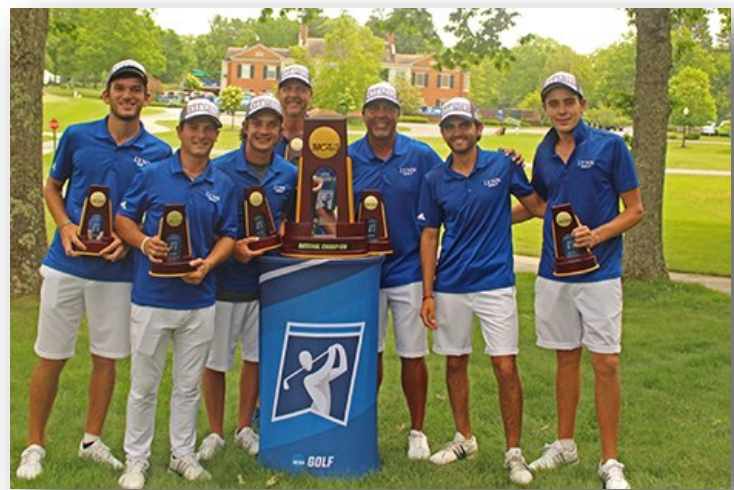

Andrew Proctor, a Desert Mashie Junior and the recipient of the WSGA 2019 Scholarship for AZ/CO/TX area and his team at Ferris State University won a shared 3rd place in the 2019 NCAA Division II National Championships held in Hot Springs, Ak on May 10, 2019 which advanced them to play in the NCAA-II Men's golf Championship in Daniels, WV on May 20-24, 2019. Although the team did not finish in the top 10, but they were ecstatic to have progressed that far. Andrew is now serving an internship in the Boston, Ma. area at the Essex County Golf Club, Manchester by the Sea for 8 months. He is accomplishing the goals that he set for himself.



Andy Walker, son of Leonard and Juanita Walker and former Desert Mashie Junior, is the Head Coach at Lynn University in Florida. Lynn Men's Golf took home its first NCAA National Title in Daniels, WV in May. This is Andy's 7th National title—2 as a player, 3 as an Assistant Coach and 2 as a Head Coach.
